Reporting to the Technology Lawyer, the ICT Lawyer is responsible for providing legal support in connection with UEFA's technology needs, working and liaising regularly with UEFA's ICT unit.

## Key responsibilities

The ICT Lawyer's main duties include providing legal support for the ICT unit in contracting corporate and event-related ICT supply and implementation arrangements, including tenders and contracts.

The ICT Lawyer may also be required to assist the Technology Lawyer from time to time in connection with other matters relating to UEFA's wider activities.

The ICT Lawyer's duties include:

- Protecting UEFA's overall interests from a legal and business affairs perspective;
- Cooperating and communicating with other lawyers in the Commercial & Technology Legal Services unit and other units of the Legal Affairs division as needed to ensure the coordination and consistency of UEFA's policies and compliance with UEFA's commercial programmes and projects;
- Cooperating with the Procurement unit, which oversees the application of UEFA's procurement-related governance regulations and framework.
